

Summary of Panama Executive Decrees

Last Update: March 26, 2020

Executive Decree No. 251

Tax contributors will have a 120 days term (4 months) for tax obligations that were due during this period (only DGI). Some exceptions apply like ITBMS

Executive Decree N° 507 of the 24th of March, 2020

24h mandatory quarantine nationwide. For most people the only time they will be allowed to transit to retrieve groceries or medicine will be using the last NUMBER of their PASSPORT. 30 minutes before and 30 minutes after that time (total 2h). Older adults or people with special needs should run errands between 11:00 a.m. and1:00 p.m (regardless of Passport No.).

This decree prohibits purchasing alcoholic beverages.

Executive Decree N° 506 of the 24th of March, 2020

Suspension of all construction industry activities for 30 days.

Executive Decree N° 504 of March 23, 2020

Mandates that all nationals and foreigners have to comply with the orders of the Ministry of Health regarding quarantine and isolation.

If someone suspects they have COVID 19 they have to quarentine in your home or any other place indicated by the Ministry of Health and you have to anwer to all of their calls or texts.

Fines of 50k-100k are in place for not obeying this orders.

Resolution N° DM-131-2020 of Marth 12th, 2020 by the Ministry of Labor

The government extends all work permits for 15 days from this date

Executive Decree N°71 of March 13, 2020

Allows companies to modify the job hours and suspend contracts if their operations have been affected and thus making imposible to continue with the employer-employee relationship.



Executive Decree N° 499 March 19, 2020

Established sanitary controls in certain areas: Chepo (Panama), La Espiga (Chorrera) Balneario El Lago, Capira, Interoceanic bridge Maria Chiquita (Colon)

Resolution No. 040-2020-DG-AAC

Suspends all international flights in accordance to Executive Decree N° 241 of March 14, 2020

Resolution N° 5893 March 16, 2020

From March 17, 2020 only citizens and residents (temporary or permanent) are allowed to enter to the country.

All of them have to comply with the norms the Ministry of Health mandates, and quarantine for 14 days.
